

## Medicare Part D Enrollment Event Made Process Easy

On April 5<sup>th</sup> 129 Medicare beneficiaries received one-to-one help comparing Medicare Prescription Drug plans and enrolling in a plan that best meets their needs.

Older Minnesotans and persons with disabilities came to the Hennepin County Brookdale Library seeking information and assistance from Linkage Line specialists. Together, they explored options and in many cases, beneficiaries enrolled in the plan of their choice, right on site. Secretary Mike Leavitt of the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services stopped by to raise awareness and visit with beneficiaries.
